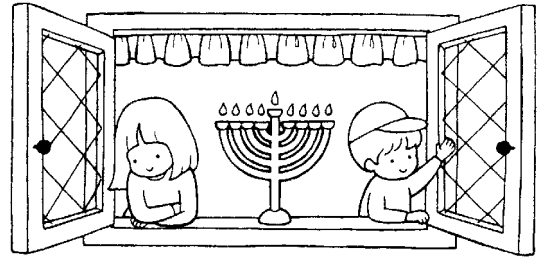

Health Corner

"Oh Chanukah, Oh Chanukah, come light the menorah...."

There are more house fires in the month of December than in any other month of the year. There are over 10,000 candle related fires in the United States each year. The following recommendations will help you ensure your family has a safe and happy Chanukah.

- * Place your menorahs on a sturdy, non-flammable surface that is large enough to hold the menorah and catch any wax or oil drippings.
- * Place the menorahs far from flammable objects, such as window treatments, upholstered furniture, and wrapping paper.
- * Keep small children and pets away from a lit menorah. Never leave small children and pets alone in a room with a lit menorah.
- * Store matches out of the reach of children
- * 40% of candle fires occur when candles are left unattended. Do not leave the house or go to sleep with lit candles.
- * Make sure your house has working (when did you change the battery?) smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers.
- * Review your family's fire escape plan.
- * When shopping for toys for little children (especially kids under 3 years old) it's a good idea to keep in mind that anything small enough to fit through a toilet paper tube is a choking hazard.

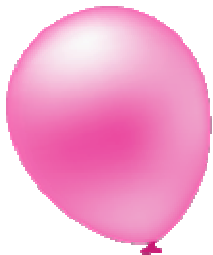
