Reminder – Main Under Construction



Main Street is under major construction from Skokie Blvd. to Crawford Avenue. Although the street will never be completely closed, at times, it will be narrowed to one lane in each direction and there will be parking restrictions. The Skokie Police have asked us to remind our parents to drive slowly through the construction zone.

There will be limited or no parking along either side of Main Street at times during the construction. The Skokie Police have told us that we can continue to have morning drop off as usual. Please leave extra time to get to school as the traffic will be backed up and very slow.

Please leave extra time when coming into school because you may have to park a block or two away from the building. In respect to our staff and faculty, there is no parent parking in either parking lot except at the end of the day to pick up students from the Kilpatrick lot. The residents of Elm Terrace have been informed by the Skokie Police that there may be extra cars parking on their street during the construction. If you park on Elm Terrace, make sure that you are parked legally (not within 8 feet of a driveway or corner).

Thank you for your cooperation and patience during the construction.
