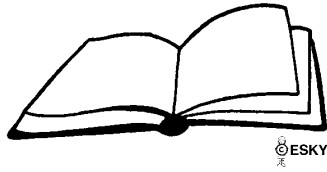
### Seasonal allergies on the rise:

According to Amanda Staudt, Ph.D., National Wildlife Federation climate scientist and lead author of the new report, ***Extreme Allergies and Global Warming***, many allergy triggers are worsening as a result of global warming. Tree pollen is the most common trigger for spring hay fever allergies and this season (spring) the pollen counts are worse (higher) than they've been for the past few years. Nine states in the upper Midwest, lower Mississippi Valley, and Northeast are identified as hotspots for large increases in allergenic tree pollen. The pollen production is closely linked to the carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. Fall allergies, primarily caused by ragweed, are also getting worse.

**This is especially bad news for the millions of asthmatics in the United States whose asthma attacks are triggered by allergens.** They will have to cope with more abundant and severe allergens as well as increases in ozone pollution at ground level, particularly in urban areas. High ozone concentrations can trigger asthma symptoms and make bronchial airways less able to cope with allergens.
