### Bus/Carpool Notice

We would like to thank all of our parents and staff for their cooperation with our pickup and dismissal procedures. Working together will enable us to ensure a safer and smoother process.



In cooperation with the Skokie Police Department, please note the following:

**MORNING:** Parents will be allowed to stop on Main Street for a few moments to drop off their children only. If you leave your car for even a moment, the police will ticket you.

**The Kilpatrick parking lot is for teachers only.** If you wish to drop your child off near that entrance, it must be from Kilpatrick Street.

**Pre-School Parents** who would like to bring their children inside the building should park on either side of Kenton or in the Kenton Parking Lot. Those wishing to park on the west side of Kenton must go around the building on Elm Terrace and come around onto Kenton. **Please be careful not to speed, and pay extra attention to stay on the correct side of the road while driving on Elm Terrace. K-turns and double parking on Kenton are strictly prohibited. Using driveways to turn around is illegal and will be ticketed by the Skokie Police.** Drop-off for pre-school begins at 8:10 AM.

**AFTERNOON:** The North Side of Main Street and the West side of Kenton are reserved for buses only – if you stop for even a moment, you will be subject to a ticket. The Kilpatrick parking lot will be available at 3:55 p.m. for those who choose to carpool instead of using the bus.

If you are parking on Main Street **ANY OTHER TIME** during the day, please do not park directly in front of the school in order to leave space for deliveries.

**BUS INFO:** We are working with Agudath Israel to try and fix up glitches and routing errors, etc. Please e-mail any concerns or questions to [bus@ariecrown.org](mailto:bus@ariecrown.org). Any approved requests for route changes will not go into effect until after Sukkos. Please do not call the school office regarding busing questions except in urgent situations. Please do not call the bus company.

### SCHOOL BUS SAFETY



About 22 million students nationwide begin and end their school day on a bus. Buses are considered nearly 2,000 times safer than the family car. Most student injury or death is not from crashes,

but due to entering and exiting the bus. Here are some common bus safety tips for your children:

- Have a safe place to wait for the bus, away from traffic and the street.
- Stay away from the bus until it comes to a complete stop and the driver signals to enter.
- The area around the school bus is considered the 'Danger Zone.' Students are advised to stay five large steps from the front of the bus and three large steps from the side of the bus when walking around

it. NEVER walk behind the bus and stay away from the wheel wells.

--At your stop, wait for the bus to stop completely before getting up from your seat.

## Health Corner

An open letter to all parents:

We want to welcome each of you and your children to another new and wonderful year at our school. The ATT School Nurse Consultant is here to help ensure the health and safety of your children.

The ATT medication policy remains the same as last year: **ALL** medication **must** be labeled and accompanied by a **WRITTEN PHYSICIAN'S AUTHORIZATION** and signed by a parent or guardian. Short-term medications such as antibiotics, eye drops, cough medicine, and cough drops, etc. are not given at school per school policy unless absolutely necessary. If you have any questions, please call the school office **prior** to sending any medication to school.

Please return all **ALLERGY ACTION PLANS** and **ASTHMA ACTION PLANS** accompanied by the necessary medications immediately.

Please report all communicable diseases (i.e. chicken pox, strep, scarlet fever, pink eye, lice, etc.) that your child may contract **directly** to the school office. If you child will not be in school, please call the school office to report the absence.

Finally, if there are changes in the work numbers or emergency contacts, please call or stop by and let us know. It is very frightening for a child to become injured or ill and the office to be unable to reach a parent. Legally we are obligated to call 911 if we cannot contact a parent or your designated emergency contacts within a reasonable amount of time.

As always, please feel free to contact the office with any health concerns you have regarding your child. We know that optimal learning can only take place when your child is healthy and comfortable in the school setting. We look forward to a wonderful school year!

Dear Arie Crown Parents: Welcome back to a wonderful new, exciting year in speech! I am looking forward to seeing all my former students and greeting my new ones.

In the first few weeks of school I will be screening all first graders, students new to this school (at the parents' or teacher's request), and returning students previously enrolled in 2008-2009 for speech eligibility.

My goal is to get students in and out of speech as quickly as possible, thus home practice is essential! The more diligent the child is at practicing, the sooner they will remediate the speech disorder.

\* Speech services fill up very quickly; therefore, if you have any speech concerns about your children, fill out the speech request form in the office or call the school and leave your child's name, grade, teacher, and reason for concern (i.e. articulation, stuttering, etc.)

After my 1<sup>st</sup> grade screening, I will contact the parents of students that may qualify for speech services. Services are offered for thirty minutes per week.

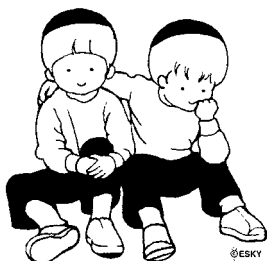
